Sandwell's 29,000 Tenants and Leaseholders are being asked to have their say over the future of the housing service.

The service is currently run by Sandwell Homes, an Arm's Length Management Organisation (ALMO) of the Council. The Council's contract with Sandwell Homes is due to end by October 2014.

Now the Council wants to hear from tenants and leaseholders:

**Should the housing service continue to be run by Sandwell Homes until October 2014**
